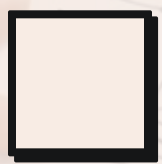
The Act remains the default global blueprint. Trustworthy AI framework is unchanged so far, but with streamlined execution.

California, Brazil, Japan are already adopting similar models. Safety + transparency is becoming the universal requirement.

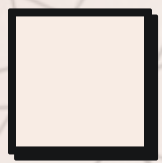
